We are still limited to 15% of fire code capacity in person at any one service. Therefore, we are not able to have more than 120 people present at a service.

Office hours are Monday - Thursday: 9:00 a.m. - noon, and 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. On Friday the office is open from 9:00 a.m. to noon. We will guarantee seating for the first 120 people who pre-register for worship. When one service is full, hopefully, you will still be able to pre-register for the other service, if you choose to do so. In this way, we should be able to accommodate everyone who wishes to attend a worship service. If there are any of the 120 seats remaining on Sabbath morning, we will allow some walk-ins. However, we cannot guarantee that you will have a seat if you come without pre-registering. Other restrictions previously in place will continue as before.
