On February 3, 2021 the church was informed of a positive case of COVID-19 in our church community. The impacted individual is quarantining according to AHS guidelines. A deep sanitization of all areas affected in the College Heights Seventh-day Adventist Church has been implemented. Anyone identified as a close contact of the confirmed COVID-19 case has been contacted.

Sabbath worship services and Sabbath Schools, which have been open, will continue following the 15% capacity restriction as set forth by AHS. As added safety precautions, we are encouraging small groups and leadership meetings to happen online wherever possible.

We thank you for your continued caution to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Masks continue to be required inside the church building as well as two-metre social distancing, and avoiding unnecessary close contact with individuals around you.
